What is Starfish Early Alert?

Starfish is a tool that provides an online space for instructors to connect with their students about class performance. Through Starfish, instructors can activate a network of support for students that extends beyond the classroom.

Participating LBCC instructors can provide students with feedback in the form of a kudo, flag or referral. Staff also have an important role in Starfish. They can assist with resolving flags or raising kudos.



Kudo is a form of providing positive recognition




Flag is a form of alerting a student to academic concerns and prompting action



Referral is a way of connecting students to resources and services to help them succeed
