Elementary Astronomy

UC & CSU Transferable

Topics to be covered include the physical nature of the solar system, stars and stellar systems, galaxies and the universe as a whole, including their current state and theories of their origin and evolution.

History of American Woman

UC & CSU Transferable

This course is a survey of the history of women in America from the pre-colonial period to the present. Emphasis is on the relevant political, economic, intellectual, and social roles filled by American women

Physical Anthropology

UC & CSU Transferable

This course introduces concepts, methods of inquiry, and theory of biological evolution and their application to the human species. Topics include principles of genetics and evolution, human variation and bio-cultural adaptations, comparative primate anatomy/behavior, and fossil evidence.
