STOP ONE: COURSE READINESS

Ahead of your class start, **assess your study skills** like time management, study skills, organization tactics, online etiquette, and support options for online classes. You may need to **learn new tools**, like Canvas. These are still important for in-person and hybrid courses, but you'll also need prep to get there: get a parking permit or a free bus pass to take care of **transportation needs** and use **campus maps** to find your classroom ahead of your 1st day or schedule a tour to avoid being lost or late.

STOP TWO: BASIC NEEDS

STOP THREE: SUPPLIES
