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Statement of Legal Residence (SLR) Instructions for Undocumented Students

Undocumented students should follow these guidelines when completing the *About You* section of the UC application. For more information, read AB 540 Nonresident Supplemental Tuition Exemption.

CITIZENSHIP & RESIDENCY

- From the drop-down menu, choose *No selection* for your country of citizenship.
- If you do not have a U.S. Social Security Number, a DACA Social Security Number or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), simply leave the social security question blank.
- Respond to the questions about attending and graduating from a California high school.
- Click Save & continue.

STATEMENT OF LEGAL RESIDENCE

- To the question: Would you like to be evaluated for California residency for tuition purposes?
 respond Yes.
- Click Save & continue.
- Respond to the question about your own physical presence in California and about attendance at a California high school.
- Note: Current or planned immigration status in the United States will be prepopulated as Other for any student who chose No selection as their country of citizenship in the previous section.
- Students born before 1/1/2000:
 - Have you established California as your permanent home for the past 366 days or more?
 Select Yes.
 - o Read and check the acknowledgements, then click Save & continue.
- Students born after 12/31/1999 respond to parent questions as follows:
 - Have you and your parents established California as your permanent home for the past 366 days or more? Select *Yes*.
 - Has Parent 1/Parent 2 been physically present in California for the last 3 years? Select Unknown.
 - o Is Parent 1/Parent 2 a U.S. citizen? Select *Unknown*.
 - Read and check the acknowledgements, then click Save & continue
- Special Circumstances, Nonresident Supplemental Tuition Exemptions, and Tuition Waivers
 - Select I believe that I qualify for an AB 540 nonresident supplemental tuition exemption, based on the number of years I have attended school in California.
 - Click Save & continue.

AFTER ADMISSION

 After admission, students who responded to the questions as instructed on this worksheet will be required to submit additional information for AB 540/residency determination to the campus where they choose to enroll.
